CHAMBER ORCHESTRA 'MOSCOW VIRTUOSI'

Artistic director, general manager and soloist of the Chamber Orchestra 'Moscow Virtuosi' is the outstanding violinist and orchestra conductor Vladimir Spivakov, a prominent Russian public figure. It is thanks to maestro Spivakov and the years of hard work that the Chamber Orchestra "Moscow Virtuosi" has become one of the best chamber orchestras in the world, with an excellent reputation and a growing appreciation from the public.

LEZGINKA STATE DANCE ENSEMBLE OF DAGESTAN (RUSSIA)

Founded in 1958, the ensemble has a multi-ethnic composition that is out of the



ordinary. More than 35 artists represent colours and traditions of over 30 different peoples of the Caucasus, a phenomenon that has no analogues in the world.

THE MOSCOW SRETENSKY MONASTERY CHOIR

The choir is composed not only of monks and students of the seminary, but also by singers of the Choral Art Academy Choir, the Moscow Conservatory and the Gnesin Academy of Music. The thirty choristers regularly participate in international music competitions and missionary journeys of the Russian Orthodox Church. They also perform for the most solemn occasions at the Moscow Kremlin.

THE TATAR STATE PHILHARMONIC NAMED AFTER G. TUKAY

For 75 years this historic institution of the Republic of Tatarstan has organised concerts and is actively involved in all the cultural events of the Tatarstan government.

COSSACK GROUP OF SINGING AND DANCING 'STANITSA'

Founded in 1981 in Volgograd, the Group is winner of several awards. The most recent is the National Award of the Volgograd region in 2010.
