The International Commercial Arbitration Court at the Chamber of Commerce and Industry of the Russian Federation (the ICAC at the RF CCI) is an independent permanent arbitration institution located in Moscow, Russia. The ICAC is the leading arbitration institution in Russia and in East European countries which deals with resolving disputes of international nature. It is the successor to the Foreign Trade Arbitration Commission (FTAC), legislatively created in 1932.

Established in 1930, Maritime Arbitration Commission (MAC) became the first permanent arbitration institution to emerge in this country, and it now ranks among the world's oldest maritime arbitration institutions. MAC was originally founded solely for consideration of the disputes arising out of salvation of the shipping and cargos on the sea. Nowadays the Commission hears both the traditional disputes from the contracts of carriage, affreightment of vessels, marine insurance, rescue, collision between seagoing vessels, fishing operations, and the disputes incidental with the broker and agency contracts, repairing of the vessels, vessel management, the realization of the trades and many other forms of relationships which appear in the area of the trade maritime traffic. Since 1999 MAC is a member of the Federation of Commercial Arbitration Institutions.

The Milan Chamber of Arbitration (CAM) is a special agency of the Camera di Commercio di Milano Monza Brianza Lodi, specialized in commercial dispute resolution. CAM provides an array of services and tools known as ADR (Alternative Dispute Resolution), which allow for a time effective resolution of disputes through extra-judicial methods.

The Department of Private International and Civil Law was the first in the country to include a direct reference to private international law as the focus area and specialty in its name. It currently teaches and conducts research on a wide range of subjects primarily related to legal regulation of property interests arising in the area of international economic relations. The main volume of teaching load falls on the International laws Faculty and in particular on the Division of international trade law for which the Department is major.
